The 8th April, 1977

No. 15-Leg./77.—The following Act of the Legislature of the State of Haryana received the assent of the Governor of Haryana on the 7th April, 1977 and is hereby published for general information.—

Haryana Act No. 8 of 1977.

THE PUNJAB BHUDAN YAGNA (HARYANA AMEND-
MENT) ACT, 1977.

AN

ACT

to amend the Punjab Bhudan Yagna Act, 1955, in its application
to the State of Haryana.

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Haryana in the Twenty-
eighth Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Punjab Bhudan Yagna (Haryana Amend- Short title.
ment) Act, 1977.
2. For sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 4 of the Punjab Bhudan Amendment of section
Yagna Act, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), the following 4 of Punjab
sub-sections shall be substituted, namely :— Act 45 of
1956.
“(1) The Board shall consist of a Chairman and such other number
of members not more than ten and not less than six, as the
State Government may, from time to time, nominate.
(2) The State Government shall appoint one of the members to be
the Secretary of the Board.”
3. In sub-section (1) of section 6 of the Principal Act, for the words Amendment of section
“Shri Acharya Vinoba Bhave or the Central Committee for Bhudan Yagna 6 of Pun-
Silver Jubilee”, the words “the State Government” shall be substituted. jab Act 45
of 1956.
4. (1) The Punjab Bhudan Yagna (Haryana Amendment) Ordinance.) Repeal and
1977 (Haryana Ordinance No. 4 of 1977), is hereby repealed. saving.
(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken
under the principal Act as amended by the said Ordinance shall be deemed
to have been done or taken under the principal Act as amended by this
Act as if this Act had come into force on the 25th day of February, 1977.
